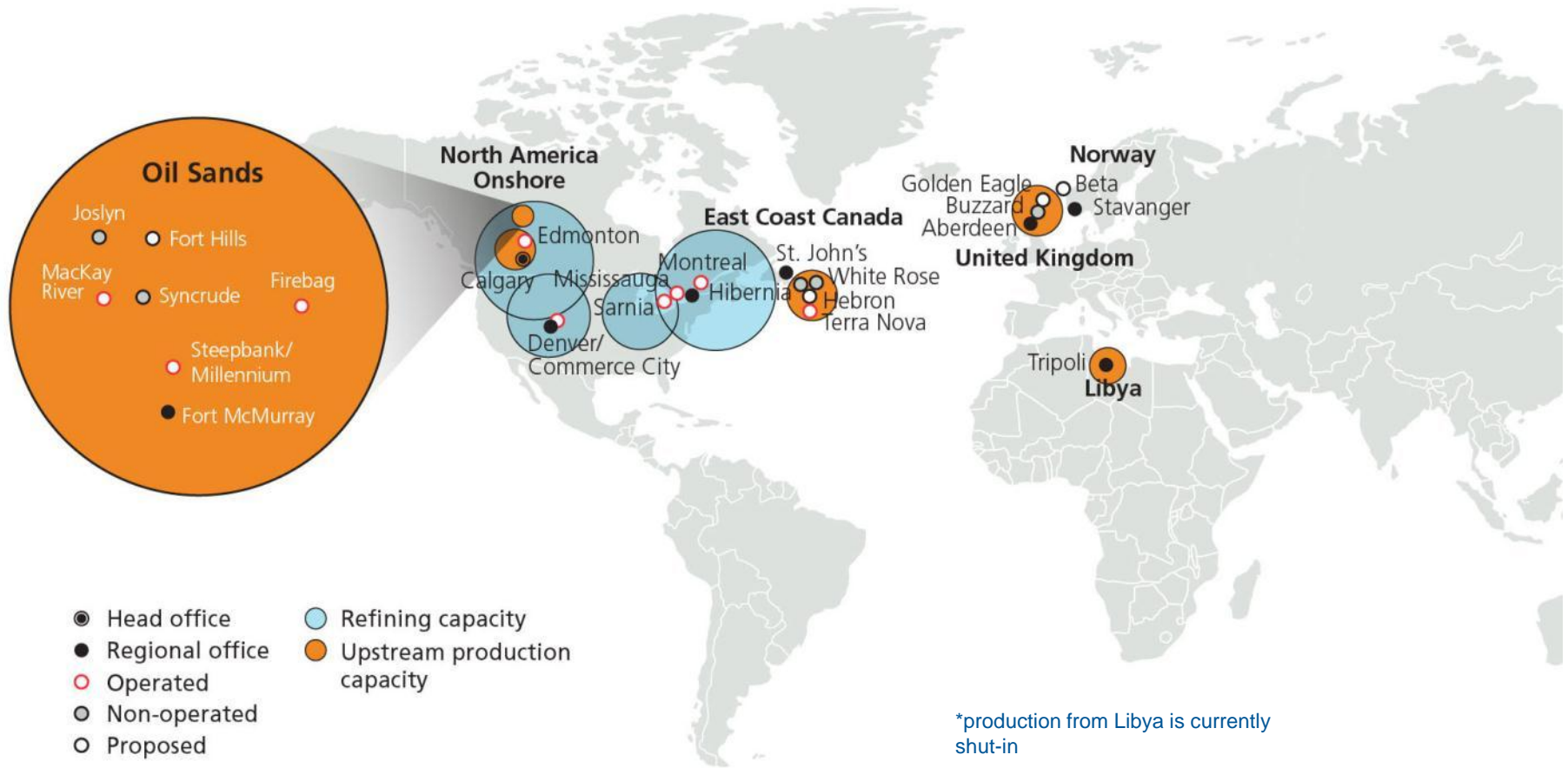

## SUNCOR REFINING & MARKETING

- Links upstream resources with consumer demand
- Refineries in:
  - Edmonton, Alberta
  - Sarnia, Ontario
  - Montreal, Quebec
  - Commerce City, Colorado
- Total capacity: 462,000 barrels per day
- Operates 1,055 miles of 25 different pipelines throughout North America



# SUNCOR U.S. OPERATIONS

- Major contributor to Colorado's economy since 2003 through these businesses:
  - 98,000 bpd refinery in Commerce City; only petroleum refinery in Colorado
  - Crude oil pipelines from Guernsey, Wyo., to Commerce City, Colo.
  - Supply & distribution
  - Retail gasoline & diesel stations
  - Crude trading



## SUNCOR U.S. OPERATIONS

---

- Typical Crude Slate
  - 40% Colorado Crudes
  - 35% Wyoming Crudes
  - 10% Other Domestic Crudes
  - 15% Canadian Crudes



## SUNCOR U.S. OPERATIONS

---

- Products are important to Colorado's growth & well being
  - Supply ~35% of Colorado's gasoline and ~55% of Colorado's diesel fuel
  - Supply ~1/3 of Denver International Airport's jet fuel
  - Large supplier of paving grade asphalt used for roads in Colorado
- Generate ~5,000 good-paying direct & indirect jobs in Colorado
- Conduit for renewable energy through purchase, blending and sale of ethanol & biodiesel, as well as wind power development

## SUNCOR U.S. OPERATIONS

---

- Invest heavily in operations in Colorado
  - Since 2003, Suncor has invested more than \$1.3 billion through capital investments in Colorado
  - Colorado crude purchases exceed \$1.2 billion per year
  - Reliable operation of the Suncor pipeline & refinery benefits Colorado citizens with stable gasoline & diesel supplies
  - Suncor's overall direct & indirect economic impact on the state is estimated at ~\$2.5 billion annually
- Invest in the communities where we operate
  - In the past five years Suncor has contributed more than \$5 million in community investment projects that foster sustainable communities
